# BRIDGESTONE WATER STEWARDSHIP POLICY

At Bridgestone, we understand the importance of freshwater supply and its value to the global community and believe fresh water should be equitably shared. In fact, less than 1% of the earth's freshwater capacity is immediately available for global daily needs. Global climate change, an increasing population and an expanding global economy further threaten the sustainable balance of the freshwater supply.

We consider water an essential resource for our operations; without it we would be unable to meet the global demand for our products. At Bridgestone, water is required for cooling and creating steam in our manufacturing processes as well as cultivating and processing natural rubber, an essential raw material.

In support of the global community's effort to preserve fresh water as a resource, Bridgestone is committed to researching and developing technologies to minimize water use by, among other items, implementing rain harvesting solutions in our manufacturing operations, producing low soil compaction agricultural tires and developing renewable low-water natural rubber crops. We accept the challenge and the responsibility to explore water preservation and conservation opportunities within our operations and to focus on opportunities that sustain and preserve the water cycle.

The Bridgestone Group has developed the following "Bridgestone Water Stewardship Policy," as part of *Our Way to Serve*, which contains "Our Mindset" and "Our Way". We intend to contribute and do our part to help ensure the use of fresh water is socially equitable and the water cycle is preserved for future generations. The policy also reflects our commitment to respect international engagements such as the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
